DATA PROTECTION IS PROTECTION OF **FUNDAMENTAL RIGHTS**

In the EU

Article 8 of the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights: "Protection of personal data"

In Germany

Right to data privacy







Protection of the individual

= data protection

Protection of data

= IT security



Individuals have a fundamental right to make their **own decisions** as regards the disclosure and use of their personal data.

German Constitutional Court, Census Decision, 1983




THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IS GOVERNED BY DATA PROTECTION LAW

- This applies whenever you process data that can be associated with a person.
- Data protection law does not protect data concerning legal entities, organisations, industry associations, etc.



... are the legal basis of data protection.







PERSONAL DATA What's that?











PERSONAL DATA means all information relating to an identified or identifiable person.



A person is **IDENTIFIED** if their identity can be determined directly from a data item.





A person is **IDENTIFIABLE** if their identity can be determined from a data item in combination with other information.



IP address



Cross-check against provider data

Far stricter rules apply to the processing of special categories of personal data because these are subject to special protection.
